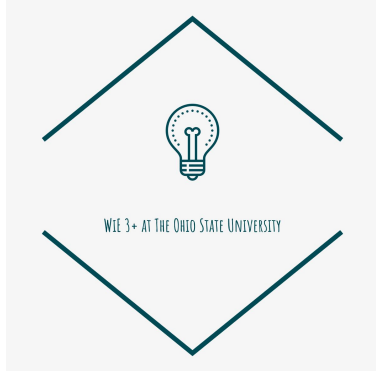

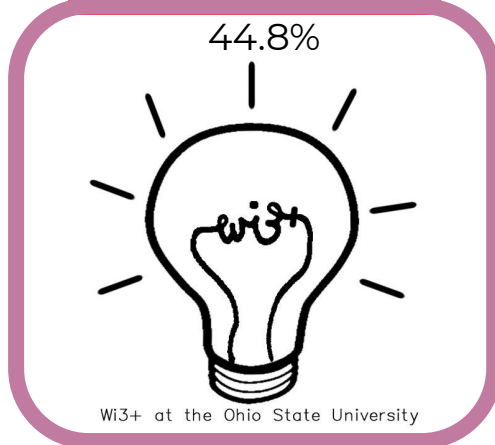

Treasurer
